Brownrice Internet is committed to operating a sustainable business and reducing our environmental impact. This report summarizes our electricity usage, on-site solar production, renewable power from our utility provider, and the purchase of Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) to achieve 100% renewable electricity on a net annual basis.

Brownrice Internet's annual electricity consumption is matched with renewable energy from on-site solar, our utility provider, and retired Renewable Energy Certificates.

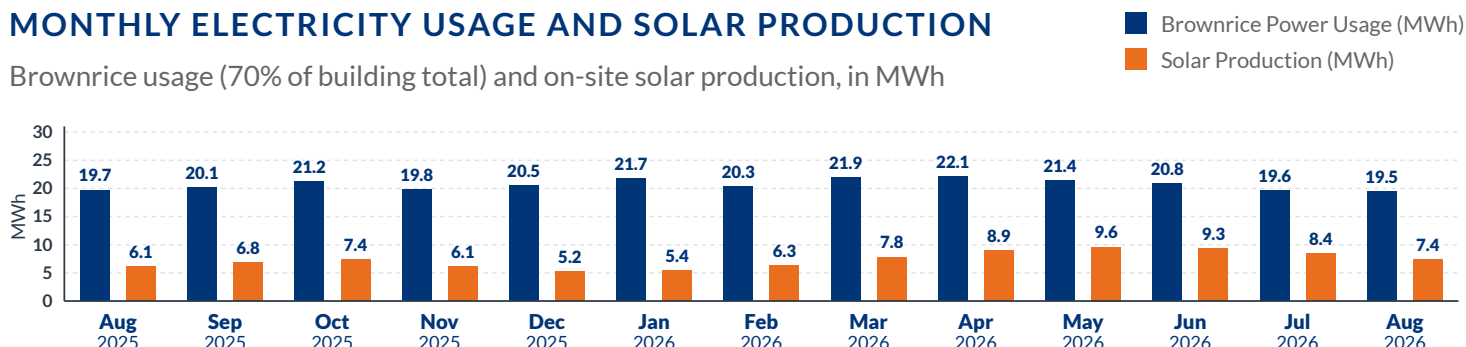

Through our on-site solar array, the renewable power provided by KCEC/Guzman Energy, and the retirement of 110 MWh of Terrapass Renewable Energy Certificates, Brownrice Internet has matched 100% of our annual electricity consumption with renewable energy on a net annual basis.
